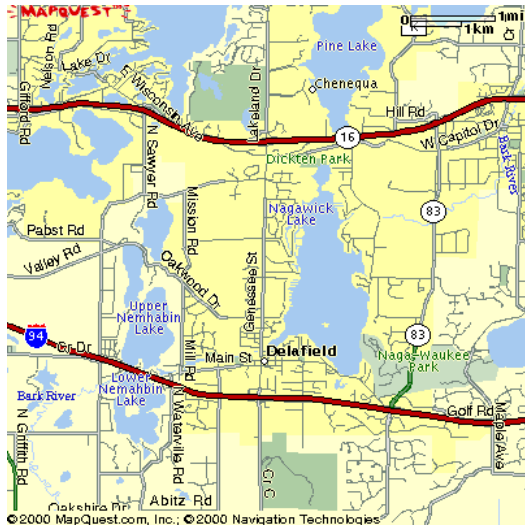

From Milwaukee: Take I 94 west to Hwy 16. Take Hwy 16 west 9 miles to Hwy C. Go north on Hwy C ½ mile to Nashotah Park;



entrance is on your left. Once in park, stay left to south picnic area.

Alternative: Take I 94 west to Hwy C. Go north on Hwy C about 4 miles, crossing over Hwy 16, entrance is on your left. Once in park, stay left to south picnic area.

From Madison: Take I 94 east to Hwy C. Go north on Hwy C about 4 miles, crossing over Hwy. 16, entrance is on your left. Once in park, stay left to south picnic area.

Location

The BMDCSEW Draft Test will be held at Nashotah Park, a Waukesha County Park approximately 45 minutes west of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Nashotah is a beautiful park with ample parking, shade trees, picnic tables, restrooms, grills if you would like to cook out, and a pavilion. Good trails are available for the freight haul. Please bring your own chairs.

Note: There is a daily entry fee for this park.

Regulations

Entrants are responsible for obtaining the BMDCA Draft Test Regulations and being familiar with them. (Available from Dottie Schulte 1943 Mountview Drive, Greeley, CO 80631 (BMDCA Ways and Means) \$2.50 each, payable to BMDCA, or: www.bmdca.org/pages/Draft_Test_Regulations.php

Entered dogs must be 24 months old or older on the Draft Test day. Open Draft entries must include a veterinary certificate stating the dog's name and weight. This certificate must be dated within 60 days prior to the date of the test.

Handlers must provide their own rigs, harnesses and tie downs or other means of securing a load on their own particular rig. Handlers are responsible for providing their own weight for the freight haul. Please contact the Test Secretary if you have questions or concerns about this.

Bitches in season are not allowed to compete. A refund will be given for bitches in season in accordance with BMDCA Draft Test Regulations. Contact the test Secretary for details.

The two dogs of a brace need not be owned by the same person or by the handler.

Draft Test Prizes

The following prizes are offered by the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Southeastern Wisconsin:

Each dog with a passing performance will receive a SWISS BELL.

All entrants will receive a ring favor

Draft Test Fees

The entry fee is \$30.00/\$45.00 for Brace. Classes offered: Novice, Novice Brace, Open, Open Brace. Entry Limit: 20 teams.

A separate entry form must be filled out for each dog of a brace team and then stapled together. Even though two entry forms are required

for each brace team, each brace team will be counted as one entry in the Draft Test entry limit, and only one fee is required.

A random drawing will be held within 48 hours of the closing date for each group that exceeds the test limits. All entrants will be notified by mail of their status. Alternates will also be drawn and may compete given the absence of regular entrants.

Entry priority shall be: 1) BMDs have preference over all other breeds. 2) Untitled teams have preference over titled teams.

If entries exceed the test limit, the above priority shall be used to create 4 groups which are applied to the test limit in order:

1) Untitled BMD 2) Titled BMD 3) Untitled other breeds 4) Titled other breeds.

Close of Entries

Entries close at the Test Secretary's address on Thursday, **September 10, 2009 at 6:00 pm CDT.**

Entries cannot be accepted, altered, changed or cancelled after this time.
