
### GCH Shepherd's Patch Quest for Serenity ND

Please let Carri Lindblom-Borisch know if you are wanting to participate. Rules follow (the parade officials are very strict):

PARADE THEME: A float or unit entry for a business, group, or club MUST be decorated and/or signed to reflect one of the following: cheese, dairy farming/agriculture, or Swiss heritage. Entries not following the theme information specified on the application form may be removed from the parade line-up at the discretion of the parade committee. (Wear Swiss or Bernese Mountain Dog-related clothing, add flowers to your cart or dog's collar, etc)

Bring your well-trained, nicely groomed, Bernese Mountain dogs on a 6-foot or shorter lead, with no visible pinch/prong collars.

Owners and dogs walking or pulling a cart are both wanted for the parade.

We must keep up with the parade for the entire 2 miles. If you fall behind, then you must move to the side and catch up without interfering with other units. Some years it has been very hot on parade day. Be prepared by carrying water and ice for your dog.

If you are handing out items and start to fall behind, we ask that you please stop handing out and catch up. Parade officials will be monitoring the flow at intersections – please follow their directions. For the enjoyment of the viewers, please try to stay within a reasonably close distance to the unit ahead of yours.

An Update Bernese Mountain Dog DNA and Tissue Repository.

Because of the outstanding participation of the dedicated Berner community ,the Repository has to date acquired over 3500 blood samples and over 450 frozen tumor samples stored. A portion of these samples have been used in several key collaborative studies, including with Drs. Benoit Haden and Catherine Andre in France, with Dr. Elaine Ostrander at NIH, and several studies directed by Dr. Vilma Yuzbasiyan-Gurkan and colleagues at Michigan State University. All of these studies have greatly improved our understanding of cancer in our Berners, contributed to development of ways to assess inherited risk of developing cancer, identified several potential therapies for histiocytic sarcoma and pointed to the possibility of early detection of cancer through liquid biopsy. You can read about some of this exciting progress on our Success Stories page.

It is thanks to you the Berner Community and your commitment to health that has contributed to these advances. However, we have all decided that it is best for us to focus our attention on two fronts: one, recruiting samples focusing on specific studies going forward, and two, focusing on obtaining updated health information on the samples in the Repository and in the Berner Garde Database in general. It is for this reason, general submissions to the Repository for blood, tumors and litters will be suspended, effective immediately. The Repository will continue to be maintained at Michigan State University by Dr. Yuzbasiyan-Gurkan.

Going forward look for surveys the Repository Team has crafted as we continue to press for updated health information. The most important thing you can do now is update health records. The health information that you provide is <u>invaluable</u> for researchers, breeders, and the entire BMD Community.
