

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. For a detailed description of the National Owner-Handled Series, please visit the AKC website NOHS pages at:

*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

**A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Best Veteran in Show Special Attraction Competition Saturday Only

WKC offers two Veteran classes - Non-Regular Veteran class for INTACT Veterans, judged prior to Best of Breed, offered both days. Saturday only - Special Attraction Veteran class open to altered exhibits. INTACT Veterans compete for Best of Breed/Variety. The winner of INTACT Veteran is automatically eligible to compete in the Veteran Special Attraction.

Saturday only - Exhibitors may enter intact or ALTERED dogs directly in the Veteran Special Attraction - competition held after Best of Breed judging.

The Special Attraction competition will include the winners of the Intact Non-Regular Veteran Classes and any directly entered dogs. Veteran Group Judges will be posted at the Superintendent table at the show.

EXPO RULES AND RV GUIDELINES

THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. Anyone who either ignores the directions of the Parks staff at the gate or bypasses them in some manner will be subject to an Event Committee Hearing, per the Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc.

- The only vehicles allowed within the show area (within 50' of all rings), are First Aid, Security, Expo Staff, and Waukesha Kennel Club, Inc. dog show staff. All private golf carts, utility vehicles, and ATVs must be used around the outer perimeter of the event.
- Day RV Camping ONLY in Gate #1. No overnight parking will be allowed. Anyone who chooses not to abide by this rule will be asked to move their RV to the overnight RV camping area through Gate #3 and will be required to pay the appropriate overnight fees. Noncompliance will result in your RV being towed at your expense.
- Entrance to RV Camping is Gate #3. Upon arrival to Gate #3, participants will need to provide a copy of their registration confirmation. Once registration has been verified, an admission pass will be provided to be displayed in the window of the RV. Access to Gate #3 is limited to:
 - Recreational vehicles with proper admission pass displayed. One extra vehicle per RV site. Mirror hanger provided for the extra vehicle.
 - Handler/Exhibitor vehicles with proper Admission pass. Any handler/exhibitors without proper pass must purchase admission and display admission pass. **NO DROP OFF will be allowed without proper pass display.**
 - Club members, Judges, Volunteers and workers with appropriate pass (Friday – Sunday).
- After 10:00 P.M., RVs are welcome to enter Gate #3 to be staged in Arena West Parking Lot until the next morning. No electrical hookups available. Wednesday arrivals are welcome from 3:00 P.M. until 10:00 P.M. and Thursday - Saturday 6:00 A.M. until 10:00 P.M.
- A noise curfew is in effect from 10:00 P.M. until sunrise. This applies to all types of loud noises, including, but not limited to, music and stereos. Please be considerate of your neighbors so everyone can have a pleasant time.
- Grills are allowed by individual RV sites only, not on the show grounds. Hot coals should not be dumped into Expo trash containers or dumpsters. Absolutely NO campfires of any kind are allowed.
- No tent camping will be allowed.
- All dogs must be kept on a 6 feet or less leash, unless in designated dog show rings.
- All campers are responsible for cleaning up and properly disposing of all trash, recyclable items and dog droppings. Place items in proper receptacles found throughout the Expo Grounds. All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. NOTE: In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.
