New Exhibitor Briefing

Friday & Saturday, February 27 & February 28, 2026

A New Exhibitor Briefing will be held each day 30 minutes before any conformation judging is scheduled.

Exhibitors are expected to keep the grounds clean, BOTH AT THE SHOW SITE AND THE HOTELS. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the show weekend with no monies refunded.

OBEDIENCE / RALLY REFUNDS & TRANSFERS

Bitches in Season: Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, and the event secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, a full refund will be due the exhibitor.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b.

ROUTES TO THE SHOW

From South: Take Highway 45 North to County Highway PV. Exit East on PV; entrance to Fair Park will be immediately on the left.

From North Take Highway 41 South to County Highway 60. Go East on Highway 60. Go North on Highway 45. Exit East on PV; entrance to Fair Park will be immediately on the left.

UNLOADING & PARKING

The designated unloading area is in the back of the Pavilion Building, which is very close to the grooming area. There will be signs. As you face the building to the right (east) of the Ziegler building is Gehl Road. Take that back towards the small animal buildings. First road to the left is Hartford Savings Circle; take a left and drive behind the Ziegler Building. Just past the Washington County Farm Bureau building is a grey building on your left that is the back of the Pavilion building. There are double-wide glass doors. After unloading, very limited parking behind the building, with additional parking to the front left of the Pavilion building.

Take this east for 12 miles (approx. 19 minutes). Turn right onto Port Washington Road. Clinic will be on the right.

Day Crating ~ there will be a reserved area for day crating (no grooming tables) & unpaid grooming; however, **NO ELECTRICAL** service is in that area. **Reserved Grooming** ~ Reservation form in the premium. \$25 for an 8 x 8 space for both days. Includes electrical service; please bring your own extension cords. **No dogs may be left overnight in the building**

BREAKFAST / LUNCH

There will be no food concession stand offered this year at our show site. Complimentary coffee will be provided in the morning. Water and soda will be available for purchase both days.
