
#### BMDCSEW March 6, 2021 Back 2 Back Judge's Comments

Thank you to all exhibitors and the committee for the honor and pleasure of judging your specialty. It was a great opportunity to see many beautiful dogs. Overall, there were many outstanding entries... but my final placements excelled in breed type, substance and movement. I was pleased to see so many with beautiful markings.

As in any large entry, there are breed specific things that show up which can be improved. Asked to critique the entry... overall I found little to fault... but a few had snipey muzzles, round light eyes, fine bone, inadequate spring of rib, and lack of moderate angulation. Some were weak in pastern and lacked the muscle tone and angulation for the proper reach and drive required for a Bernese Mountain dog. Generally, I thought the bitches were stronger than males. There were many very promising youngsters, and I was thrilled to see so many wonderful veterans.

One of the great pleasures of judging a specialty is to have so many good dogs that you can create a final lineup that is consistent with your interpretation of the breed standard. Kudos to all the others who placed in their classes and to all the beautiful specials and veterans. I just did not have enough ribbons to go around.




## **BREEDER REFERRAL 2021**
