

Seiger Show report

I had the pleasure to judge the Sieger test for the BMDCSEW Saturday May 11, 2024. I want to express my sincerest gratitude to the BMDCSEW for asking me to evaluate the animals, for the people who entered their dogs for me to evaluate as well as Sue Lutz, for being my keeper of notes, and going through each section of each evaluation with me. Now to write about the puppies, and adult dogs I had the pleasure to evaluate.

Puppies can be very hard to evaluate, as puppies (especially Berner puppies) change overnight. Overall, the puppies were put together well, and had very nice portions, and were sound. I did want to see a little more stop, slightly shorter muzzle, and more back skull on some of the puppies, but I was overall pleased with type, portions, and movement.

Temperament on the puppies were sweet, but slightly unsure to make with how to show, but nothing too serious to fault on. My best puppy in evaluation, was an 11 month old male who had a lot of type, clean movement, and good portions on his body. He has a lot of potential, and I look forward to watching him

The adult animals appeared to have different strengths and weaknesses, but it should be noted that some of the animals were slightly over the 1 year mark, and still weren't at full maturity. Overall, the animals had good portions to match their bodies, and for the

continuing his show career

most part were sound. I did observe undershot bites, varying degrees of eyes from being loose and round, to tight and oval, slightly sloped toplines, different front and rear angles, and animals lacking markings. My least concern is and always will be markings, as it has nothing to do with having a "working dog". My breed winner was an 18 month bitch. She was very sound, and balanced, and her portions matched her body.
