OBEDIENCE & RALLY EXHIBITORS - - - PLEASE NOTE:

Bitches in Season: Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season, and the event secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, a full refund will be due the exhibitor.

Transfers (formerly called move-ups): After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed. A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16b.

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Bernese Mountain Dogs 6 months of age and under 24 months of age on the day of the show. All entries in Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular class entry fee. Sweepstakes class and age division must be indicated on the entry form under additional classes.

For dogs that are four months of age and over, but under six months on the day of the event.

- AKC registration # or an AKC litter # is required.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies).
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, however, must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES – FRIDAY & SATURDAY

(Entry Fee, Per Day, for Veteran Sweepstakes is \$20.00)

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Bernese Mountain Dogs 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. **Veterans do NOT have to be entered in a regular class.** Sweepstakes class and age division must be indicated on the entry form under additional classes. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in this class.

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won their three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Fees for rally include the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and \$3.50 for each additional entry of the same dog. Note: There is no recording fee or event service fee for junior showmanship, sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes or special attractions.
- 2) Please note that rally is a separate event from the specialty (conformation & obedience); therefore, you must pay the first entry fee (not the additional entry fee) if you also are entering in conformation or obedience.
- 3) Fee for **4-6 Month Beginner Puppy** includes the \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee per entry.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – PLEASE READ!

- *LIMITED ENTRY. Conformation is limited to the first 200 entries per day. Entries will close once these limits are reached. Obedience & Rally Limits are listed on the cover page.
- •NO ENTRY SHALL be made or accepted which specifies any condition to its acceptance.
- •ENTRIES SHALL NOT be accepted without signature and fees. All entries must be on official AKC entry forms.
- •ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts, including extreme weather conditions, beyond the control of the management; it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry shall be made.
- •POST-DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BMDCSEW will add a collection fee of \$25 to the amount of each returned check. If acknowledgement of entry is not received by exhibitor within a reasonable period of time, please notify the show secretary.
- •NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
- •ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
- •DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. (The building will be open at 6:00 a.m.) Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- •NO DOGS will be allowed in the building overnight.
- •NO SMOKING IN BUILDING.
- **•ELECTRICITY WILL BE LIMITED.**
- •NO PRIVATE exercise pens in the building. Grooming allowed in designated areas only.
- •EXHIBITORS must exercise their dogs in the designated areas and pick up after them.
- •JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- •ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- •CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
- •NO GENERATORS are permitted inside any building.
- •NO DOGS UNDER 4 MONTHS OF AGE ARE PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING. ONLY DOGS THAT ARE AKC ELIGIBLE ARE ALLOWED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
- •EXHIBITORS should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Wisconsin laws require dogs over 4 months of age to have current Rabies vaccination.
- •DOGS found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.
- •THE BMDCSEW DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THESE EVENTS.
- •TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms or Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.
