Changes to two club policies that were voted on at the July Meeting.

<u>Awards Policy</u>. The Board has updated the wording as requested by membership at the February meeting. The main two points were to include BMDCA Top Producers and AKC Achievers. Following is the Policy as the Board is proposing it. Deletions are struck through and additions are underlined.

Annual New Title Awards

Each year in February, members that have placed a title on their Bernese during the previous year receive an award at the annual Awards Luncheon. To be eligible for an award the following accomplishments must be met:

- 1. You, the owner or co-owner, must be a member in good standing with the BMDCSEW.
- 2. The dog must reside with a member of the BMDCSEW or a member in good standing must have done the majority of the showing/testing. Breeders that are co-owners who do most of the showing can get an award even if the dog does not live with them.
- 3. The dog must have completed the requirements and received a certificate from the AKC, UKC, CKC, BMDCA or a Therapy Dog Organization. for titles in the following categories: Conformation, Obedience, Draft, Herding, Rally, CGC, Agility, Tracking, Working Dog, Versatility, Therapy, and/or Temperament Test

4. Members of the BMDCSEW who own or co-own a dog that achieves Top Producer status with the BMDCA is also eligible for an Award.

To receive the award at the Awards Banquet in February, an Awards Application must be completed sent with a photocopy of the title certificate to the Awards Chair. Awards Applications will be made available at the end of the year.

Breeder Referral Participation Policy. The old policy required working at one event a year and be a member in good standing.

Dues must be current. Breeder must be a participating member of the BMDCSEW for at least 2 years and a voting member for 1 year.

Pet puppies will be sold on a spay/neuter contract and limited registration. All litters will be registered with the AKC with full litters entered in Berner-Garde. Breeders and stud dog owners shall accept responsibility for all the puppies they produce. Parents of litters will be current in Berner-Garde and have OFA/Penn Hip evaluations of hips and elbows.

The BMDCSEW strongly recommends current eye certification, testing for vWD or clear by parentage, cardiac evaluation and DM testing and have that entered in Berner-Garde.

Breeder should have exhibited in an AKC or BMDCA show or trial within the last 2 years.

Breeders must follow the BMDCSEW code of ethics.

Breeders are required to attend 2 general meetings per calendar year and chair one event, being in attendance or work on two committees. Breeder referral chair will verify that these requirements are met before breeder is placed on the website.

2018 Draft Test

Our club hosted three BMDCA Draft Tests again this year on Friday 9/28, Saturday 9/29, and Sunday 9/30. Our judges were Karyn Beyer from California, Val Horney from Colorado, and Phil Atkinson from Massachusetts. The number of entries was 13 on Friday, 16 on Saturday, and 11 on Sunday. Several entrants were absent for various reasons, so the total number who actually participated was a bit lower.

Friday, we had 13 entries. Of that, 2 were absent, 2 open passes, 2 novice passes, 7 novice fails.

Saturday, we had 16 entries. Of that, 4 were absent, 2 open passes, 2 open fails, 3 novice passes, 5 novice fails.

Sunday, we had 11 entries. Of that 3 were absent, 3 open passes, 1 open fail, 3 novice passes, 1 novice fail.

The weather was cool which was great for the dogs. There was rain overnight but we got lucky that it held off during the day except a bit misty on Sunday morning.

There were a few other breeds besides BMDs entered – two Leonbergers, a Bouvier des Flandres, a Greater Swiss Mountain Dog, a St Bernard, and a Shetland Sheepdog. It was enjoyable to watch the other breeds working draft!
