



5 Tips Before You Take Your Dog to the Store

As with anything new and exciting, it's best to prepare your pup before bringing them to a dog-friendly store.

Understand that not all dogs can or should go in stores and not all dogs will enjoy the experience. If your dog is easily distracted or is showing signs of <u>stress</u>, fear, or <u>anxiety</u>, it's better to turn around, go home, and try some other fun activity together instead.

- 1. A dog must be <u>socialized</u> and have successfully learned <u>basic training</u> and respond to <u>cues</u> and recall before attempting to take them in a store around other people and potentially other dogs.
- 2. Your dog should always be leashed while in a store, which means they should be comfortable on a lead.
- 3. Pack a <u>water bowl</u> and <u>treats</u> to ensure they remain hydrated depending on the weather and how long you will be away from home.
- 4. Just in case a store asks for it, have a record on your phone of your dog's <u>vaccinations</u>.
